


Fair Justice or Selective Justice?

Case study. Cases of Filat, Platon and Shor




LRCM has analysed the grand corruption cases of Vlad FILAT, Veaceslav PLATON and Ilan SHOR. The analysis below reveals issues demonstrating selective justice in these cases, such as the duration of preventive measures and criminal proceedings, place of detention, indictments and court findings, imposed punishments, etc.





Note: Ilan SHOR continues to hold the office of mayor in Orhei and judges allowed him to travel abroad several times.



WHAT WAS THE INDICTMENT AND WHAT HAVE **THE COURTS FOUND:**

	Charge	Requested sentence	What have judges found?
Vladimir FILAT	Received bribes from Ilan Shor about USD 250 mln.	 passive corruption and influence peddling 19 years with imprisonment 	convicted on both indictments Bribe was of USD 23 mln.
Veaceslav PLATON	Obtained by fraud about USD 58 mln. from the banking system and money laundering of the defrauded amounts	 <u>fraud</u> and <u>money laundering</u> 23 years with imprisonment 	convicted on both indictments
Ilan SHOR	Abuse of office with serious consequences, as chairperson of the Administration Board at Banca de Economii	The case has not yet been submitted to court	
CASE 2	Obtained by fraud USD 350 mln. from the banking system and money laundering of the defrauded amounts	 fraud and money laundering 19 years with imprisonment 	 convicted for money laundering, but the court reclassified the fraud into a less serious offence by <u>causing damages</u> (becau- se it did not find that Mr. Shor benefited from the defrauded money) Judges found that the caused damage was


