

PROMOTION OF PROSECUTORS FROM LAW TO REALITY

January 2019 – May 2021

Most contests for executive positions had **only one candidate**. In most cases, these positions went to persons who had been appointed by the prosecutor general to fill them **on an interim basis**.

TRANSFERS AT THE PROPOSAL OF THE PROSECUTOR GENERAL

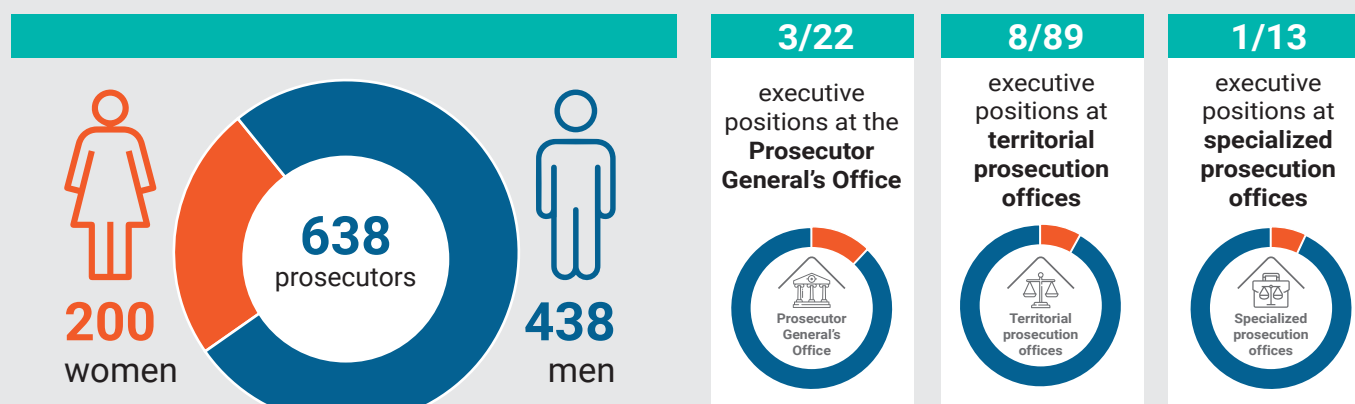


Untransparent and discretionary transfers **strengthen prosecutors' dependence** on the prosecutor general.
